TECH TIP: ***Altitude & Airflow Calculator***

When you install a system in a high altitude location, it is important to take into account how your system airflow changes. Airflow drops 4% every 1,000 feet of altitude. You can calculate adjusted recommended max operating pressure based on **the following formula:**

$$\left(\begin{array}{c} \text{Recommended} \\ \text{Fan Operating Pressure} \end{array} \right) - \left(\begin{array}{c} \text{Recommended} \\ \text{Fan Operating Pressure} \end{array} \times \frac{\text{Altitude}}{1,000 \text{ ft}} \times 4\% \right)$$

Actual Maximum
= Fan Operating Pressure
(Adjusted for altitude)

EXAMPLE:

GP501 Fan Operating in Denver, CO at Elevation of 5280 ft

$$\left(\begin{array}{c} 3.8'' \\ \text{Recommended WC} \end{array} \right) - \left(3.8'' \times \frac{5,280 \text{ ft}}{1,000 \text{ ft}} \times 4\% \right)$$

$$= 3.0'' \text{ Actual WC}$$

Using this formula for other popular RadonAway fan models, the RP145 actual WC reduces to 1.3, and RP265 reduces to 1.7 at 5,280 ft.
