Radon Rick's Tech Tips: Backer Rod

For new mitigators and "old pros", installation of backer rod seems routine. But is it?

- For a long crack, it's better to use a 100' length (if available in the correct size) than 6' lengths.
- Use backer rod slightly larger than the crack width.
- Push the end of the backer rod into the crack, pull and stretch in the direction of the crack, and press into place.
- For a very wide crack, use half round backer rod, with the flat side up, to make it self leveling.
